NOTE - INVITING FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

Government by its Notification No. ED 121 DCE 2018, dated 21-03-2022, have notified Karnataka Examinations Authority as the Examination Authority to conduct Competitive Examination for recruitment to the posts of Principal (UG) in Government First Grade Colleges in the State of Karnataka. Accordingly applications are invited from the eligible candidates as per the provisions laid down in "Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020" and corrigendum notification No. ED 121 DCE 2018 dated 21.03.2022. Applicants have to appear for the Competitive Examination to be conducted by the Karnataka Examinations Authority.

2) **Tenure and Pension:** As prescribed in Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020.

3) **Fees:** Fees should be paid before the last date fixed for receipt of prescribed Fees.

The payment has to be made in the "Computerized Post Office" branches only after completing the application and downloading the challan from KEA website. Fee relaxation will be given to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes, Category-1 & Persons with bench mark disability of more than 40% and those who are holding a disability certificate issued by District Health Officer. However bench mark disability candidates will have to pay processing fees of **Rs.2500/-**.

4) **Method of Applying:**

Candidates have to apply only through online by browsing the correct URL in the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>
There is no pen and paper method of applying.

5) **Qualification:**

As prescribed in Rule 3 of the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020.

6) **Competitive Examination details:** Candidates have to download the admission tickets from the KEA Website when notified and admission tickets will not be sent to individual candidates. The Place of Examination and Competitive Examination Time Table will be notified later in the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>. The dates for Competitive Examination will be announced on the KEA Website in due course.

Syllabus: As specified in Rule 8 of the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020.

Note: There will be no Negative Valuation.

- 7) Compulsory Kannada Language Exam – As specified in **sub-rule (2) of Rule 3 of the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020**, any candidate shall not be eligible for selection unless he/she has qualified in the Kannada Language Test. The exam should consist of a question paper of maximum 150 marks. Candidates should score at least 50 marks to qualify in this paper. This question paper will be at the standard of SSLC.

Provided that, if a candidate has passed the SSLC examination or any equivalent examination or any examination higher than SSLC in which Kannada is the main language or second Language or an optional subject (but not one of the subject in composite paper) or has passed in Kannada medium, he/she is exempted from the Kannada language exam.

- 8) Candidates are informed to visit KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> for Cadre wise details of Academic Eligibility Conditions, Competitive Examination Papers and Mode of Selection and Appointment, and also the number of cadre wise and category wise vacancy positions.

NOTE:

1. Mere applying online, appearing for Competitive Exam and qualifying in competitive exam does not confer any right to the candidate for recruitment of the above posts, and it is subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria as may be prescribed by Government.
2. All rules governing the conditions of service of Government Servant made or deemed to have been under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) is so far as they are not in consistent with the provisions of Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the posts of principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2020, rules shall apply to the persons appointed as principal (UG) under these rules.
